- Coordinate services and supports with your signed Partnership/Authorization Form

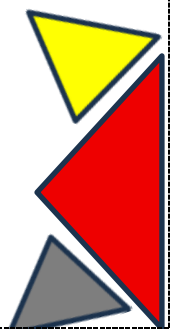
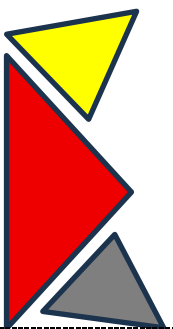
Public schools in Florida offer strong programs and services, and for many students, this is the best fit. Our team can help guide your decision based on your child's needs.
